Principal's Report (Shannon Spike):

- -Security Cameras reiterating that they are not used for teacher reports, or spying on students. They can only be viewed under specific circumstances
 - -Laura asked about adding one out back, Shannon to look into
- -have been working on cleaning up the front display cabinets
 - -will be getting cork backing and adjustable shelves to display student's work
- -cleaning out snack/storage room
 - -moved cabinets to VP room for paper storage
 - -do we need the freezer that's in there?
 - -no, ok to get rid of it
 - -do we need the display fridge?
 - -it leaks
 - -no, ok to get rid of it
- -parents need a reminder that there is no teacher supervision before 8:20am
 - -some students are being dropped off as early as 8:00
 - -Amanda to post a reminder on the FaceBook page
 - -add to February newsletter
- -there have been changes to the health curriculum specifically strand D
 - -all info is on the board website
 - -20 days before the teacher will discuss strand D a letter will go home to parents, and will need to be returned to the school if they want their children exempted from these discussions.
 - -if a student is exempt, they will be for all of strand D, not specific topics only (too confusing)
 - -will only be exempt from the planned lessons, if random conversation comes up in the class they will not be removed
- -updated concussion protocol
 - -passport is now sent home with every student when a concussion is suspected, and must come Back
 - -if it comes back 'yes', need to be clear return to school instructions from a doctor
 - -coaches need to sign off on an online module, as well as students and parents

- -mandatory for all inter-school sports
- -school's choice to do for intermural sports as well, Shannon to talk to staff and decide
- -all students and teachers will watch an online module and sign off on it
- -Paula asked if Linamar busses were already paid for (from cancelled field trips) no
 - -asked if future Linamar trips are cancelled, if parents can take their own children to the performances since tickets are already paid for?
 - -Shannon will look into if strike is still on in April before next trips
- -Belwood Grade 6 camp
 - they are willing to hold the dates for us in the hopes that the strike will be over before then -looking into insurance
 - -popcorn sales are still being done, if camp doesn't happen we'll use the money for classroom events

Teacher's Report (no teacher present):

- -Megan Scott asked Paula to bring up a health/nutrition day she's planning
 - -have applied and been approved for \$1000 grant
 - -goal is to introduce students to new healthy food and physical activity they may not have been exposed to
 - -centres in a one day rotation
 - -Terri (Tiny Bites Nutrition) is on board to come out and help
 - -maybe make a receipt book of meals students made in rotations to take home
 - -suggested to contact Egg Farmers of Ontario and Ontario Bean Growers (Paula has both contacts)
 - -Laura has contacts for Pork and Dairy they will give us take-aways (erasers, bookmarks, etc)

 - -ask Rob about dates for next year now Sep & Mar every year if possible
