Playground Update

As of June 2023, the playground fund has \$128,621.16. The process of getting a playground is complicated and wasn't clear upon commencement of this undertaking. The Playground Committee, headed by Crystal VanGerven, has been working closely with our school principal to ensure that the proper processes are being followed. In brief, there is a proposal that was submitted to the school board which they had to approve. This process took several months. Once approved, the project went out to tender and board-approved companies made bids on the project. Once the tender process is complete, there is a review of the applications and a company is selected to complete the project. We are well on our way to bringing our playground project to a reality. Woohoo!!

We wish everyone a great summer and we look forward to seeing everyone in September. Keep your eyes open for a notice about a parent council meet and greet once we are back to school. We are always looking for new members with fresh new ideas! Inclement Weather Plan:


