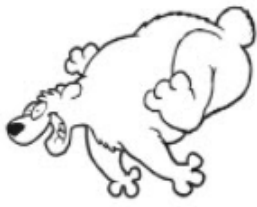

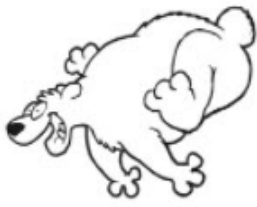
LAST AND FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

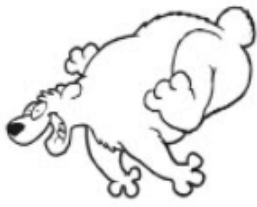
Kindergarten Registration has a pre-registration that you can find at <https://www.ugdsb.ca/kindergarten/registration/>
