

DRIVER EDUCATION

Again this year, a comprehensive course in Driver Education, approved by the Ministry of Transportation, Ontario will be available to interested students. The aims of this course are to develop the knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary for the safe operation of a motor vehicle and to assist students in qualifying for the provincial driver's licence.

Our instructors are fully trained and qualified. The cars are fully insured and dual controlled.

Students who satisfactorily complete all course requirements will be eligible for earlier licensure as well as possible insurance savings. This program is recognized by the majority of insurance companies for savings on insurance premiums and, over a period of time, these savings could substantially exceed the cost of the course. (For specific information on savings, please consult your insurance agent or broker.) But far more important is the hope that there will be fewer collisions, injuries and loss of life resulting from the unskilled use of a motor vehicle.

COURSE DURATION

20 hours of classroom or digital instruction and 10 hours of Homelink projects plus
10 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction plus optional observation time

COURSE COMPLETION

To satisfactorily complete the course, students must fulfil the following:

1. Complete 100% of all theory sessions
2. Attend 100% of all in-car training sessions
3. Obtain a minimum mark of 70% on all classroom tests and quizzes
4. Obtain a minimum mark of 70% on all homelink projects
5. Attain a minimum mark of 75% on the in-vehicle portion of the course

POLICIES

- A student must be 16 years of age before the last theory session is completed.
- A student must obtain his/her G1 licence from the DriveTest Centre/Ministry of Transportation, Ontario, as soon as possible after the course begins.
- Ministry of Transportation (MTO) Regulations require that all in-vehicle and all theory training **must be completed within one year of the start date, without exception.**
- All students will be picked up and dropped off at the high school, unless otherwise arranged.
- Arrangements for in-vehicle training will make every effort to accommodate each student's schedule.
- If a student wishes to withdraw from the course, a deduction for all in-vehicle sessions taken to date will be made plus a fee of \$25.00 to cover administration costs.
- The test for the Provincial Driver's Licence is the responsibility of the student. However, the driver training vehicle may be rented for this test at additional cost, if desired.
- Extra lessons, at additional cost, are also available on request.

As a reminder: A student must complete 100% of the in-vehicle, theory and Homelink training in order to qualify for certification. If for any reason the student is unavailable for a scheduled in-car lesson, the student MUST telephone AVEC Training Systems 1-888-691-3583 as soon as possible BEFORE the scheduled in-car lesson is to occur.

FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN THE LOSS OF THAT DRIVING TIME TO THE STUDENT. It will then be the student's responsibility to arrange for a make-up lesson with the in-vehicle instructor AT A COST OF \$40.00 PER HOUR (includes HST).
