
New Bike Rack at Centennial Hylands!

A new bike rack was installed at our school over the summer. Biking to school is a great way to get active, reduce traffic and pollution and help create safe school zones!

The rack is located at the entrance to the kinderpack. It is easy and safe to use for all sizes of bikes. The rack supports the frame of the bike, eliminating the possibility of the rack causing damage to the bike.

Bikes can be loaded onto the rack by rolling the front wheel of the bike between the two bars on the ground. You can rest the frame of the bike on one of the rings along the rack. You need a cable or u-lock to secure the bike to the rack.

Below is a map showing the location of the new bike racks as well as a photo of the new rack. A second photo is also included showing an example of how a bike can be parked at the rack.
