4	Principal’s report (Rochelle) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - November overview: Jan Sherman storytelling, children were attentive and respectful, drumming, songs and reflection - staff did a “blanket exercise” - learning the history of the native people- small blankets laid out with a few people standing on each one. Stories being told on each of the blankets - exercise was powerful, as stories were told, people had to leave the blankets based on things that happened in their culture (residential school, death, disease etc) and things being lost by the culture,as things were lost, blankets were being folded up - Rochelle reflected that teachers are still learning as are the children - \$5 cost paid by parents went to Jan for her teaching - Volleyball tournament coming up - Choir performance tomorrow at Quebec Street Mall - Food drive starting shortly - Giving Tree: donations will go to Hope House
