3.	Principal's Report (Amy) Make sure parents have access to their portal to access report cards. Report cards will be available on Feb. 15, 2023. Can be printed, just ask the office. For kids on modified or alternative IEP they will be printed. <u>Volunteers and volunteer sector screening.</u> It is a board requirement they're being asked to fulfill. Central needs volunteers right now, so not requiring it immediately, but by the end of the year it needs to all be completed. For volunteering it is just a vulnerable sector screening not a criminal record check. For Guelph Police department you don't need a letter. Turnaround time seems to be 2-3 days. Criminal record check would have to have vulnerable sector screening included as well - it doesn't inherently include it. <u>Parking at front of school.</u> Concerns about people parking longer than 5 minutes. Complaints about people idling.
