GRADE 9

Welcome to the wonderful world of cosmetology! In grade 9 students will learn a variety of skills throughout the year. Some of these skills include: Basic braiding, shampooing, round brush blow drying, scalp treatments, curling techniques and much much more!

GRADE 10

In grade 10, students will continue learning and developing their skills. Throughout the year students will also be introduced to many new skills and services in the cosmetology industry. Some of these include: Tint re touch, standard perms, straight back perms, corn rows, manicures, advanced braiding, draping a client, and flat iron curls.

GRADE 11

By the time students get to grade 11 they have the option of becoming a Specialist High Skills Major student. Through this special program students will have the opportunity to obtain many different certificates. Students will become certified in First Aid and CPR, make up, nails and nail extensions, health and wellness, conflict resolution, aromatherapy and many more.

GRADE 12

Once students reach grade 12 they are well on their way to a new and exciting career pathway in the cosmetology world. Students will be able to perform basic to advanced haircuts, full professional colours, high light and low light hair, perform a colour correction and nail extensions. They will also learn how to run their own salon.

JOB OPPORTUNITIES

There are many career paths you can take in the cosmetology industry. Some of these careers include:

Hairstylist

Provides beauty services such as shampooing, cutting, colouring, styling hair and massaging/treating scalps.

Aesthetician

Provides skin care services in medical, retail, spa or salon settings. Aestheticians can perform chemical peels, hair removal, facials, colour analysis and makeovers.

Salon Owner

The owner is responsible for managing the salon and will often work in the salon as a stylist. Some owners will rent out work space to other stylists. Most owners are stylists themselves.

Teacher/Educator

Teaching students the necessary skills to become a hairstylist. Further education is necessary besides a certificate of qualification.
