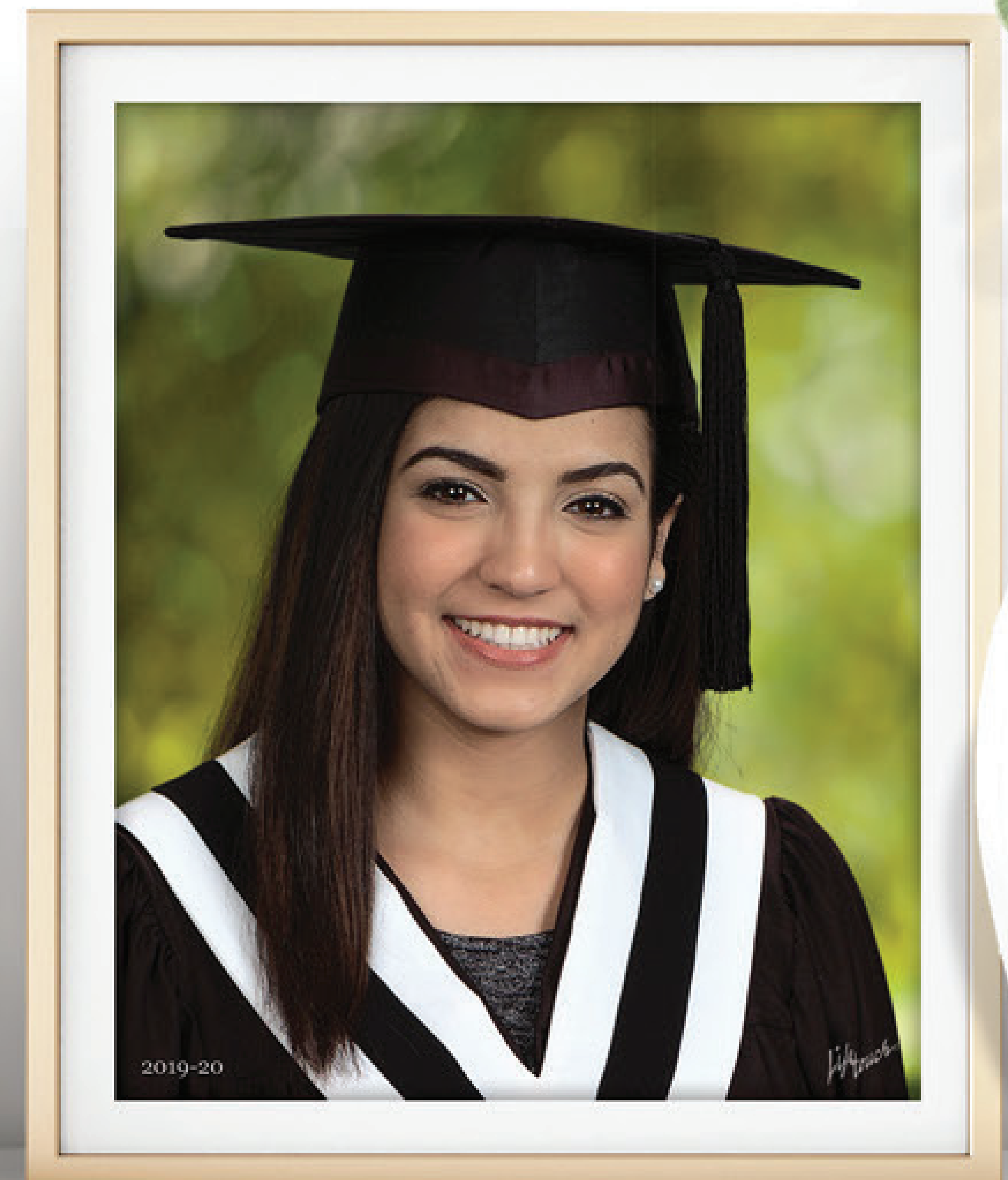


Grad Picture Day!

We've made some changes to help ensure a safe Picture Day during COVID. Please review the following information to help prepare for a great Picture Day experience.



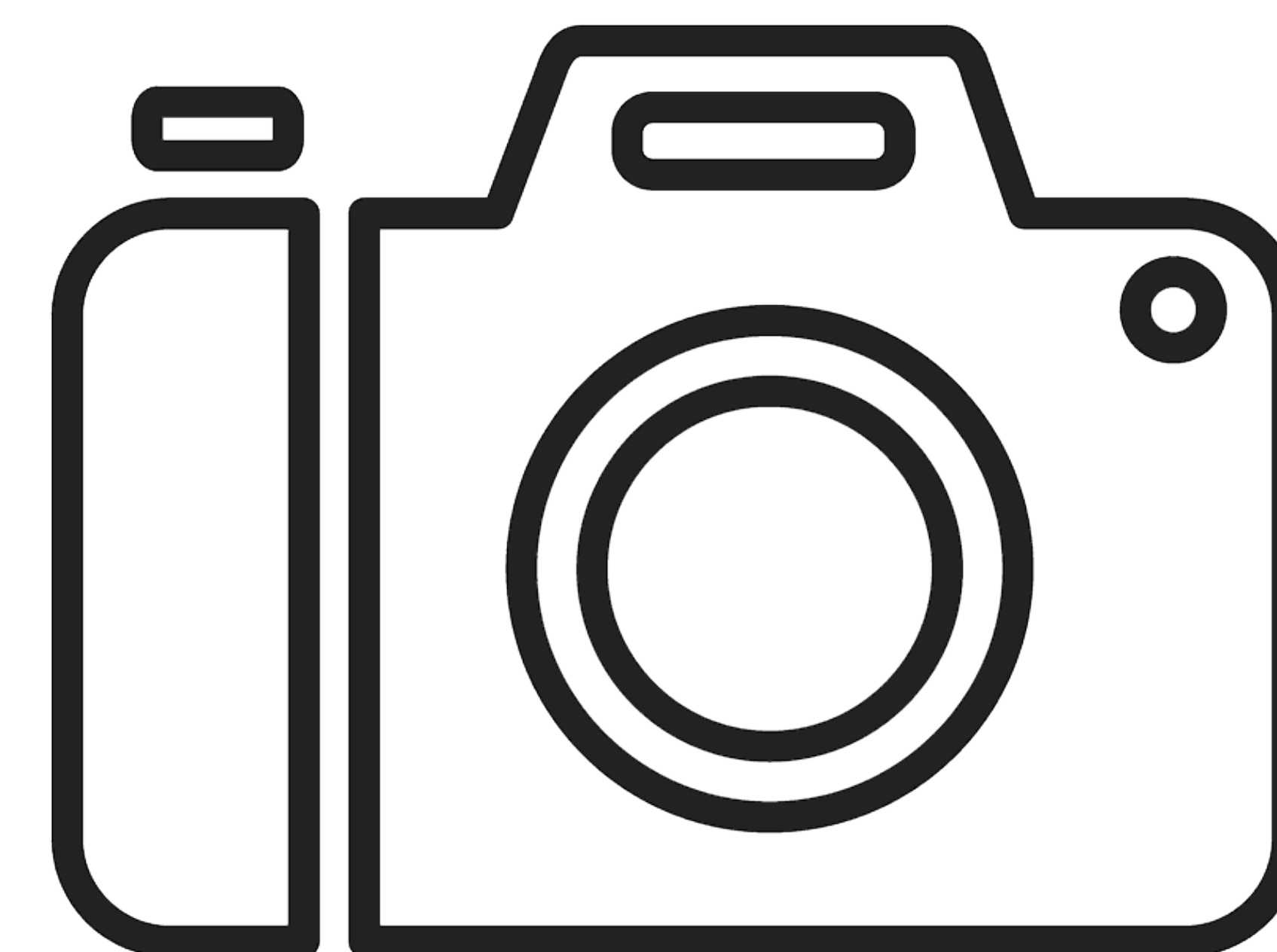
What to expect on Picture Day:

All grade 8 grads are photographed

Picture proofs will be sent home

Review proofs and make any purchases on mylifetouch.ca

Grad composite orders can be dropped off on Picture Day



To help ensure a safe and enjoyable grad photography experience, please review the following information:

- Group composite orders will be taken by the school. Please see the attached information about these orders. Payment for this will be collected by the school through [schoolcashionline](https://schoolcashionline.com).
- Students will be asked to remove their masks once safely distanced and ready for the photo. Anyone not wishing to remove their masks for reasons of safety should let their teacher and the photographer know as early as possible so accommodation can be made.
- The grad gown and sash will be provided and thoroughly sanitised with steam before use by another student. Gowns are professionally cleaned between schools. Dress shirts and ties **will not be** made available to borrow, and students will need to provide their own clothing for underneath the gown. Traditional choice are: Collared shirts and ties for boys and blouses or V-neck shirts for girls. If in doubt, anything simple and neat will work.
- Photographers and school staff can not physically assist students with their attire. This includes helping with ties or other accessories. Please consider this when selecting a tie or other accessories.
