### Fundraising at Elora PS

Dear Elora PS Families,

We are excited to share with you our School Council plans for fundraising this year at Elora Public School. We are hopeful that having families aware of our plans will help you to know what to expect for this coming year. The plan is to participate in 5 fundraisers over the course of the year. We also are offering a 6th option in the form of donations for which you can receive a tax receipt.

Funds raised throughout this year will be used to support improvements and additions to our playground, recess equipment, reducing the cost of bussing for trips, technology, pinnies for school teams and clubs and helping to pay for students who are unable to afford trips or activities run at the school.
