## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Principal Amanda Coulombe and Vice Principal Vincent Allan presented their report. It included:

- Report cards to be distributed electronically Feb. $15^{\text {th }}$
- Those students with IEPs will have paper copies sent home
- Graduation Photos are scheduled for later this week with a new vendor
- Sledge Hockey fields trips happening this week for Grade 4-8 students
- Junior Volleyball Tournament is scheduled for Feb. $21^{\text {st }}$ with a snack shack to be run
- Grade 8 trip is planned for the end of the year with two days spent in Toronto
- Popcorn sales is supporting this trip
- Dance-a-thon planned
- Cost is $\sim \$ 500 /$ student
- Grade 6 trip to Mansfield is scheduled for later this year
- Candygrams sales to help lower the cost
- Potentially chocolate bars sale in the future
- Cost is $\sim \$ 200 /$ student
- April $17^{\text {th }}$ Basketball tournament - could potentially sell the chocolate bars at that event.


## HOT LUNCH UPDATE

- Pizza lunch working well via Lunch Box
- Sub lunch orders have moved to Lunch Box as well due to complications with ordering directly via subway


## FUNDRAISING

- All the ideas around the holidays were well thought out however, it was a lot of fundraising at the same time
- Discussion ensued regarding the creation of a fundraising calendar for next school year


## EQAO RESULTS

- Primary - 30 grade 3 students, 23 wrote it, 7 students who did not participate receive a zero on the test
- $4.3 \%$ are considered special needs
- Reading - level 3 is ministry standard $-56.5 \%$, Level $434.8 \%$
- Writing - level $382.6 \%$ and level $44 / 3 \%$
- Math - level $339.1 \%$ ad level $447.8 \%$
- Overall grade 3 was positive results
- 2021/22 school year - overall $31.3 \%$ ( $39.1 \%$ this year) at level 3 and $12.1 \%$ at level $4(47.8 \%$ this year)
- Board comparison - one of the higher schools (at or above board standard)
- Grade 6-41 students in total - 23 wrote it ( $56 \%$ participated); $26.1 \%$ have IEP saying they are not working at grade level
- Reading level 3 65.2\%; level 4 13\%
- Writing level $356.5 \%$; level $417.4 \%$
- Math level 3 30.4\%; level 4 8.7\%; level 2 47.8\%; level 1 13\%
- Overall grade 6 was weaker results
- Grade 3 targeted supports this year from the UGDSB - reading, math
- Remote school had only 2 people who wrote but they are not in our results; we were able to filter them out
