What?

- This is a library of parenting books that were purchased in 2020 using \$500 from the Parent Engagement funds.
- The original intent of the library was to provide parents a method of self-directed learning during the height of the pandemic, but as restrictions are loosening the library can continue to serve that purpose while also promoting parent-parent discussions.
