








The UGDSB is situated on the ancestral, treaty and title lands of two Anishinaabek Ojibwe Nations: the Michi Saagig of the Credit and the Saugeen Ojibway Nation. This land also includes a specified tract of land granted to the Six Nations of the Grand River. These Nations hold legal and specific rights in their respective territories. This area has been and continues to be home for Indigenous Peoples and non-Indigenous peoples.

As an educational community we have a responsibility to identify and describe racism and oppression and then work to dismantle it. The Upper Grand District School Board is committed to disrupting systemic racism and oppression in all of its forms. #### Video surveillance

This is a reminder that École Fred A. Hamilton, similar to all schools in the UGDSB, is outfitted with video surveillance cameras, both inside and outside the building. The purpose of the video surveillance cameras is to ensure student/staff safety, and to help reduce vandalism at UGDSB schools. Signage is posted on the outside of the school noting that video cameras are active.

#### **Dogs on School Property**

When dropping off or picking up children, dogs must be on a leash and kept on the sidewalk off school property. This is the expectation for all Upper Grand District School Board parents/families. Some students have allergies to animal hair/dander or have a fear of dogs and there's potential for people to be scratched or bitten. Dog walking is not allowed on school property during the school day. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### Reminder - nut free, peanut free, scent free environment

We have children in our school with potential life-threatening allergies (called anaphylaxis) to various foods and other materials. Anaphylaxis is a medical condition that can cause death within minutes. Some of these include: nuts, tree nuts and soy. In recent years, anaphylaxis has increased dramatically among students. Although this may not affect your child's class directly, we are letting you know so that you are aware that we aim to create an allergy safe environment at our school.

Please be aware that some staff and students in our school are extremely sensitive to scented products such as perfumes, colognes, aftershaves, body sprays, air fresheners and pot-pourri, etc. The presence of scented products can adversely affect a person's health, including life threatening reactions. **Please do not wear or use scented products at any time in our school**. Your participation helps to ensure that École Fred A. Hamilton is a healthy and safe learning and working environment for all. Merci.

**Reorganization** - When we begin the school year, school organizations are still tentative. Principals do not have the option of changing the school organization that is set by the District Staffing Committee of the Board.
