We hope that your son or daughter has enjoyed the first week at The Guelph Collegiate-Vocational Institute and that they have settled into the routines of their new school community.

This letter is your invitation to the **GCVI Grade 9 Parents' Night** being held on **Tuesday, September 18th at 6:00pm**. Grade 9 students are welcome to attend! The evening will begin in the auditorium with a brief presentation from the school administration, school council and student senate followed by a short visit with your child's semester one teachers. You will receive information about GCVI school policies and individual courses.
