Final Evaluation Days: Wednesday June 21st-Tuesday June 27th:

Final Evaluations and culminating activities will be given during the last three or four weeks of the course. Final Evaluations must be written at the scheduled time and place. All students are expected to complete final evaluations. Students are expected to attend all final evaluations during the week of **June 21st to June 26th** unless there are medical reasons (a medical note is required) or extenuating circumstances as determined by the Vice-Principal. **Please do not schedule trips, vacations, or appointments during final evaluations.**

• Students must stay for at least one hour on each of the final evaluation days.

- Students must take any books, bags and coats with them to their final evaluations and leave them at the front of the room. Upon being dismissed from the evaluation, students must leave the building through the closest exit. Halls will only be open from 8:30am -9:00am and 11:30am -1:00pm. You will not be able to access your locker at other times. Bring everything you need to your exam (In your classroom- unless otherwise assigned).
- Please ensure that you have returned all instructional materials (textbooks, chromebooks etc.) to the library by **Friday, June 16th.**
- Students who owe the library, you may go to the library either before the final evaluation begins (time permitting) or after the final evaluation to return materials.
- Library is open only from 8:30am 12:00pm each day and will only be open for material dropoff.
- Students who need to wait for their bus or need a place to be in the afternoon can use the cafeteria.

Final Evaluation Accommodations:

Students who require accommodations or who are writing in the resource room should speak with the resource room staff before the final evaluation week. If you are writing in the resource room on a final evaluation day please report to the resource room before.

Locker Cleanout-Wednesday, June 14th (Period 1):

Students will be asked to clean out all of their belongings and remove their locks during their homeroom class on Wednesday, June 14th during period 1. After this date please bring your belongings to class and do not use the lockers for them to be cleaned. A reminder that access to lockers is limited during the evaluation period so this day is for students to bring home all items for the summer.

Grade 12 Study Day and Grade 12 Period 4 Final Evaluation - Tuesday June 20th:

This is a day designated for students in Grade 12 classes to meet with their teachers to prepare for final evaluations. Some of our grade 12's will be writing their Period 4 (Day 4) final evaluations on this day. Students are expected to attend all other classes.
