Dear Parents and Guardians,

I would like to provide you with some information regarding the planned construction of new homes behind Grand Valley & District Public School.

Town staff has informed us that site grading will begin shortly. This phase will involve increased truck traffic to and from the development site, along Main Street and along the access road next to the school.

School Board staff has worked with the Town to ensure a number of safety measures are in place to address some concerns regarding safety and increased traffic.

The developer has agreed that during the times listed below, Monday to Friday, they will have a flag person in place to control truck traffic coming to and from the site to ensure safe access to the school is provided for all students, staff, parent/guardians and residents:

- 8:00-9:00am
- 12:30-1:30pm
- 2:30-3:30pm

The developer will also install fencing and tree protection along the access road and will regularly run a street sweeper to prevent mud being tracked down Main Street.
