New Business and Updates

-Bunkie

- Has been installed and has now completed the outdoor classroom
- Gardens have become very overgrown and need regular maintenance
- Danielle asked if parent volunteers could help with cleaning out the garden and splitting some plants

- Sean said the school would be on board with having parents clean up the gardens, but would like the classrooms to also have some responsibility in helping and working with the gardens
- Tania proposed setting up a committee with volunteers to create a schedule to keep the gardens from getting out of control again
- The first clean up will be paid for by council and the students can take over maintenance now that they are back in the classroom
- Tania will contact company for the first big cleanup
- Some of the mulch that the board brings to the school will be used in the outdoor classroom to help with maintenance.

-Playground

- Repairs were made, the slide with the three slides had to be removed as it was dangerous and beyond repair
- There are limited years left with the current playground, it has become too old to fix broken parts
- We will need fundraising to pay for a new playground, they are extremely expensive but a very integral part of the school yard that the students really enjoy
- Other schools have had to raise \$100,000 for their playgrounds
- Meal days would typically be our big fundraiser to help with this bringing in around \$16,000/year
- Sean asked about leaving the current bones of the playground and just getting pieces added slowly so the students who helped fundraise would get to use it, or to start slow and buy new pieces at a time to build up to the bigger finished project
- Playpower did the park in the Fieldstone Community and it cost \$130,000+HST
- Tania asked what other families would like to see added; accessibility for all students was an important component, climbing nets and domes were also suggested
- Everyone present was asked to notice what they see kids liking at the parks and to make note to bring back to council as this will become an ongoing discussion as we try and fundraise for this project

-Fundraising Ideas

• <u>Fundscript</u> can be used all the time under ILPS login, % goes back to the school and they have amazon, grocery store etc gift cards that can be purchased

- <u>Santa's Little Helper</u> has gift wrap and bags for purchase but must have the order in soon to get with the deadline
- <u>Mom's Pantry</u> has frozen goods, muffins, cookie dough etc to be purchased through order forms
- <u>Pizza Night</u> order through Pizza companies to make a pizza night at home, Little Caesars has make our own pizza kits with \$5 donated back to the school
- <u>Mabels Labels account</u> % goes back to the school if people search for our school name
- Read-a-thon run much like our dance-a-thon, students get sponsors and log their reading minutes online. Parent Council would create incentive for students/classrooms with the most logged hours

Tania suggested a fundraising committee to work on researching ideas and then reporting back to council with ideas

Volunteers for the Committee; Christine, Danielle, Tania, Tanis and Jenny

-Scientists in the classroom

- Last year our program was changed to accommodate the needs of the classrooms during the pandemic. Teachers were given the funds to use as they saw fit in their own classroom, we would like to bring it back as it was originally planned for and have the "Scientist in the Classroom" still happen but virtually.
- Many families agreed it was a wonderful learning experience for their kids, and a benefit to the teachers as an addon to hands on learning that is preplanned for them.
- Approval to move forward was unanimous

-Meal Days

- Not allowed from the school board still
- Restaurants themselves have also contacted the board and have not heard back regarding if/when we will be allowed to restart.

Sean spoke about keeping our school inclusive and wanting to make sure we try and reach all members of our school community regarding up coming holidays and celebrations such as Halloween. Making sure costumes are appropriate.

Sean and Tania thanked everyone for being part of our meeting and are excited to work together to support students, families and teachers this year through council.
