Principal Update

New Business and Updates

Secretary Position

-Jenny Smith, who was voted in as Secretary at the beginning of the school year, is now an employee of UGDSB

-She can remain a voting parent member however cannot hold an executive position.

-therefore, will need a new parent member to take on secretary position

-Tania explained what the role would entail, which this year, only includes taking the minutes of the meetings and emailing them to Parent Members

-this role could also be shared among a few Parent Members.

-Danielle Harris agreed to take on the role, which will begin at the March meeting

Meal Days

-pizza days have begun

-good number of orders for this session, with 550 slices being ordered

-we pay \$10.25+tax for a pizza of 10 slices and charge \$2 per slice

-meal days that were postponed in January will be held in March.

-next session will run April – June. Ordering to open the beginning of March through School Cash Online.

<u>Fundraising</u>

Fundscrip

-we had a very low number of families, only 15, participate

-still raised just over \$400 from those orders

-money raised has been requested and will arrive at the school as a cheque this month -all money raised will be deposited into the Playground account

-it was mentioned that through the ongoing direct buy option, by paying with a credit card, much of the percentage that would come to the school is taken away in fees.

-Tania mentioned that, in fact, credit card payments take about 1.9% off of the donation percentage and that paying through electronic funds transfers results in no fees being taken off. -Tania will send out a reminder to all parents about this buying option, with a how to guide.

Deja Vu Weekend

-our weekend through Déjà vu Restaurant is Feb 26/27th.

-\$3 from every kids meal purchased over the weekend comes directly to the school

-all we have to do is promote it and encourage people to go

-question was raised about whether this would include take out meals

-Tania will contact Déjà vu to inquire

-Tania will send out information to all parents through email and Facebook

FunDrive

-Clothing and Household Goods Collection

-a fundraising opportunity through Value Village

-the idea of the fundraiser is that families collect items from around their homes that they would like to get rid of.

-they pay by weight for 4 different categories of goods that we collect. The categories and payment amounts are:

- Soft Goods in bags: clothing, shoes, accessories, linens
- Housewares in boxes: kitchen items, décor, toys, games, small appliances
- Books in boxes
- Media in boxes

-possibly to run end of April beginning of May, when families are switching over clothes for season and doing spring cleaning

-discussion postponed until March meeting due to lack of quorum for decision making and approval

Little Caesars

-frozen pizza kits, bread sticks, cookies

-discussion postponed until March meeting due to lack of quorum for decision making and approval

Dance-a-thon

-discussed options of how to run Danceathon this year with Covid restrictions around cohorting and no parent volunteers

-Sean suggested that instead of a danceathon day, we could run it as a week long event -each class would use one of their gym periods during the week as their Danceathon

-playlists/Just Dance lists could be made available to teachers

-funds raised through Danceathon is used to fund Scientists in the School

-also discussed that there is money in our budget to fund Scientists in the School for teachers this year and a few teachers have already booked their sessions

Playground

-Tania has emailed a few parent council members from other local schools who agreed to speak with her

-she has not heard back yet but will continue to make contact.
