Meal Day

- Pizza Day

 - o There have been some issues with Pizza Pizza.
 - They are arriving late.

 - We have raised these concerns, so hopefully this will be improved.
 - o Grab-a-Pizza is not on the board list yet.
 - Toppers is on the board list.
 - They are \$1 more for cheese pizza than Pizza Pizza.
 - Toppers sorts and labels the boxes.
 - They provide napkins and paper plates at no extra charge.
 - They also have lactose free, vegan, and gluten free crust.
 - They can begin immediately, so we will switch to them starting on Monday, November 21.
