New Business and Updates

Fundraising Plan: Full discussion deferred until January.

There have been inquiries about whether council will be holding FunDrive (clothing donations) again this year. Will discuss further in new year.

A parent also wondered about bringing back Movie Night, which is a possibility. The board has rules about the movies that can be shown. Free popcorn, people could order pizza and dilly bars.

Party Rockers was asked about however council is not allowed to host as per the Board due to too much of a liability.

Funding Request: A funding request was received from Kristen, school CYC. 2 presentations from UPower Presentations, one K-grade 3, and one grades 4-8. Provide strategies to enhance resilience and emotional and mental well-being. Total cost is \$1,350.00. The Principal stated that if parent council is willing to contribute half the cost (\$675) the school could cover the rest. This money would come out of the Fundraising general account.

Decision could not be made on the funding request due to lack of quorum. An email will be sent to all parent members to make final decision. Those present at the meeting (7 of 8 needed) all voted yes.

Other Business

Council Communications: The question was asked about the way we currently send emails and whether they could include more graphics etc. to grab the attention of the reader. Response: Due to accessibility rules with the board, the current format cannot be changed.

It was also discussed whether parent council should expand their social media from only having Facebook to having Twitter, Instagram etc. This will be looked into.
