## FIRST DAY PROCEDURES

Teachers will be outside by the entry door that aligns with your child's grade holding up their name and grade.

Teachers in vests will have class lists. They will let you know what class your child is in if you are not sure.

Parents/Guardians bring their child to their assigned class line.

#### WHAT TO BRING TO SCHOOL

Please keep your child's personal items to a minimum! To support a safe and comfortable environment, students are asked to bring the following items clearly labelled with the student's name:

- Knapsack or tote bag for personal belongings
- Personal water bottle
- Seasonal outdoor wear
- Only those items that are necessary for the day (e.g., pencil case, calculator, pens, pencils)
- Students may bring their own devices
- Phones are not recommended for school use. Teachers will review expectations



Note: Lockers will be available for Intermediate students, they will need to provide their own locks



### RECESS

• Half of the school will be outside at a time (Kindergarten & Intermediate first, Primary/Junior second)

• Outdoor play equipment will be allowed. This will be reviewed with students

### END OF DAY PROCEDURES

- Students in grade 1-3 will wait in their line for parent/guardian pick-up.
- Cars are not allowed in the front drive thru bus loading zone or in the school parking lot
- Please respect the city by-laws signs and as well our school street patrols

#### At entry and dismissal times, parents are to remain outside the school.

#### DESIGNATED ENTRY DOOR/CLASS LOCATION

To facilitate speedy entry in the morning, each grade/class will be assigned an entry/exit door. This will be the main door that students will use for entering the building, for accessing outdoor activities (and recess) and departing at the end of the school day.
