TPJ2OF- Health Care (Year A-September 2017)

- Introduction to personal health promotion, child and adolescent health concerns, and a variety of medical services, treatments, and technologies.
- Will become familiar with various instruments and equipment and will learn about human anatomy, organs, and body chemistry, as well as the effects that lifestyle choices can have on personal wellbeing.
- NO PREQUISITE
- Can be taken by students in ANY GRADE

HZT4UF- Philosophy (Year A- September 2017)

- Addresses three (or more) of the main areas of philosophy: metaphysics, logic, epistemology, ethics, social and political philosophy, and aesthetics
- Students will learn critical thinking skills, the main ideas expressed by philosophers from a variety of the world's traditions, how to develop and explain their own philosophical ideas, and how to apply those ideas to contemporary social issues and personal experiences.
- Can be taken by students in grades 11 or 12
- Prerequisite: Any university/ college course in social sciences and humanities, English, or Canadian and world studies

AVI3MF- Visual Arts (Year A- September 2017)

- This course enables students to further develop their knowledge and skills in visual arts. Students will use the creative process to explore a wide range of themes through studio work that will include drawing, painting, sculpting, as well as the creation of collage, multimedia works, and works using emerging technologies. Students will use the critical analysis process when evaluating their own work and the work of others during class critiques, as well as exploe various periods of art history.
- Can be taken by students in grades 11 or 12
- Prerequisite: Visual Arts, Grade 9 or 10
