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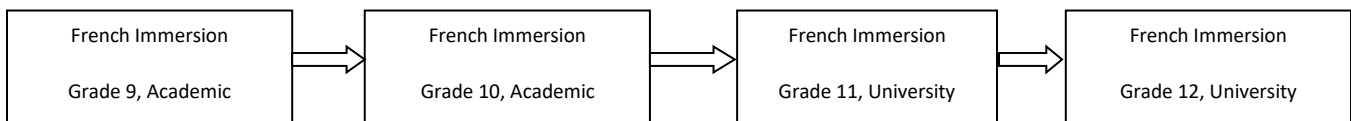
Points of interest for the French Immersion Program

- **Program requirements**
 - A certificate in French Immersion will be granted if the student has successfully completed the sequence of four courses in language and a minimum of **six courses** in other subjects taught in French (**2 of which must be senior level courses other than Language**), for a total of at least 10 courses.

- **Language of Communication**
 - In order to improve overall level of communication, **ALL** French Immersion courses will adhere to the following criteria:
 - **10% of the term mark** will be for the use of French in the classroom at all times (communication with the teacher, in class discussions, with classmates in group work settings, with classmates in informal settings) with the exception of extenuating circumstances, such as medical or situational emergencies. (See attached Rubric used for evaluation purposes)
 - **In the immersion physical education course, 25% of the term mark** will be allotted for speaking French at all times.

- **Alternate year schedule (See next page)**
 - We offer French Immersion courses on an alternate year schedule (every other year). Next year is **YEAR A** and the following year will be **YEAR B**.
