Each grade 9 student will have 2 LINK leaders who they will meet during orientation. LINK Leaders are senior students who will be their mentors for their first year of high school. The purpose of the orientation and the LINK program is to help ease the transition for grade 9 students into high school, meet new people and encourage grade 9's to get involved at GCVI.

During orientation students will take part in a number of activities as well as receive their timetable and go on a school tour.

Between August 29th-30th all grade 9's can expect a call from one of their LINK leaders who will share more information about the day and answer any questions.

It is highly recommended that grade 9 students attend orientation on August 31st; however, if anyone is unable to attend, they will still be assigned LINK leaders who will support their transition to high school.
