As a temporary solution to support the interests of families and provide much needed BASP care to families of Brant Avenue PS, which is in close proximity to Edward Johnson PS, we are accommodating registration for Brant Avenue PS students to attend the BASP located at Edward Johnson PS. We are in the process of securing a bus as a means of transportation to and from Brant Avenue PS to Edward Johnson PS.
