Between August 29th-30th all grade 9's can expect a call from their Sidekick leader who will share more information about the day and answer any questions. It is strongly recommended that grade 9 students attend the entire orientation process on Wednesday, August 31st; however, if you are unable to attend, you will still be assigned a student mentor who will assist with the transition into grade 9.
