Black Heritage, Black Brilliance and Black Futures Month:

During the month of February, it has been traditionally called Black Heritage Month. A couple years ago, UGDSB students requested that the month of February be named Black Heritage, Black Brilliance and Black Futures month. This intentional name represents a balanced approach to understanding that the history, reality, and future of people of the African Diaspora involves immense racism and injustice including slavery as well as



pre-slavery history, excellence, social justice and contribution. Throughout the month of February, students and staff at the board will also be educated in highlights of Black Brilliance, look at resources that continue to celebrate and educate, and will hear from the Black Staff Advisory group.
