

Message from the Principal

Thanks to everyone who is working to make this possible in these circumstances.

We also want to acknowledge all our volunteers who, even now, are working to help make our school great. We usually have a celebration where we honour the many parents, grandparents, and friends who contribute so much of their time and talents to support and enhance our student learning and opportunities. This year we will not be able to have that celebration but we do want to thank you and let you know how much we appreciate your dedication. Our school would not be the same without you.

As with any large school, changes in staffing are the norm. Mme Smith has started her maternity leave and Mme Buckley has taken over as the Grade 4/5 teacher. We welcome her to our staff.
