DCAFS is in the midst of a comprehensive change to our child welfare documentation system as we join a provincial enterprise system. The Child Protection Information Network (CPIN) is a single information system developed by the Ontario Ministry of Children, Youth and Family Services to ensure the safety and well-being of children and youth across the province. Through this enhanced child welfare system, CPIN will enable timely and efficient services for children and their families.

DCAFS will 'go live' in joining the provincial database on Monday, May 27, 2019. We have been preparing for this transition for over a year and will continue to provide our services throughout training and as we make the switch to the new system. *We ask for your patience up to and during the few weeks following as, together, we may experience some service disruptions given training needs for staff and system implementation.*
