MAPS Class Placement 2023/2024

We are beginning to build class lists for September 2023. Please note that all schools in our Board will be organised according to the provincial guidelines that provide "hard caps" on primary and junior class sizes. **This means that schools are likely to face reorganisation well into September**. Teachers will be tentatively assigned to specific grades, but that may change as our enrollment changes, up to and including, the month of September. The Staffing Procedure in Upper Grand is in process throughout the summer.

Question for the Principal: How does the staff decide which class to place my child in?

Answer: When school staff draft class lists, a variety of factors are taken into consideration. Some of them are as follows:

- · Total number of students (must meet Ministry and contractual guidelines)
- · Balance of female/male students
- · Balance of abilities
- \cdot $\;$ Number of students identified with special needs
- · Combinations of students (positive and challenging)
- Formation of interactive learning groups
- Teacher experience
- \cdot and lastly, parent requests

If parents/guardians wish to make a request for a particular class, it must be supported by specific and detailed reasons.

The email must specify the reason for the request. We will make every effort to honour parent requests, but please be aware that we do not guarantee that requests will be met, due to the number of variables involved in student placement. <u>Our deadline for requests to be emailed</u> to the Principal is June 2nd, 2023. We cannot accept any requests beyond this date.
