Topic / Discussion Item

Montgomery Village Update

- Family Transition Place presentations have been going on in class
- New portable has arrived; not being used this year; could be 3 more arriving to be replaced
- New portable has more natural light
- There are no temperature thresholds to reach to keep children inside during recess; up to Principal and VP
- The UGDSB website has information on school bus cancellations; the school does not determine school bus cancellations; VP and Principal just report decision made

- Request for parents to stay out of the bus lane for drop off
- No issues have come up with the removal of devices in the classroom; very positive feedback
- Feb 12 report cards will be uploaded for parents; can still call the school to get a hard copy
- Review of school wish list and money raised
 - School Council voted to pay the full amount for FTP next year; Going from the requested \$4800 to the actual cost of \$5040
 - \$1800 from Winter Wonderland to Library to offset Forest of Reading
 - \$416 from Winter Wonderland to Athletic General to be spent on DPA equip
 - \$584.19 from Meet the teacher night to Athletic General to be spent on DPA equip
 - Brent will speak with staff on any other items to put on school wish list

 - Looking to add smoothies from Pita Pit in the warmer months
 - Can provide veggie and meat sandwiches for an additional food day
 - Will see if any interest in either option through parent council survey
- Movie night
 - Discussion around setting up a movie night similar to last year
 - Need to sign into school account and pick approved movie
 - Last year a backup disc was used
 - Date to be set for before March Break
 - o Food could be provided by the school for free; cookies through the school program
 - Bring your own water bottle (BYOWB); just a fun night; no fundraising
 - o Tentative date will be March 01, 6-730pm
- Spring Fling
 - Will determine at next meeting if we want to have a spring fling/goodbye picnic
 - Big commitment and volunteers needed
- Emily Press Labels and FlipGive account have been set up
 - Send out email to parents to notify it is ready for use
- Discussion on creating a survey on what parents think of the food options at school
