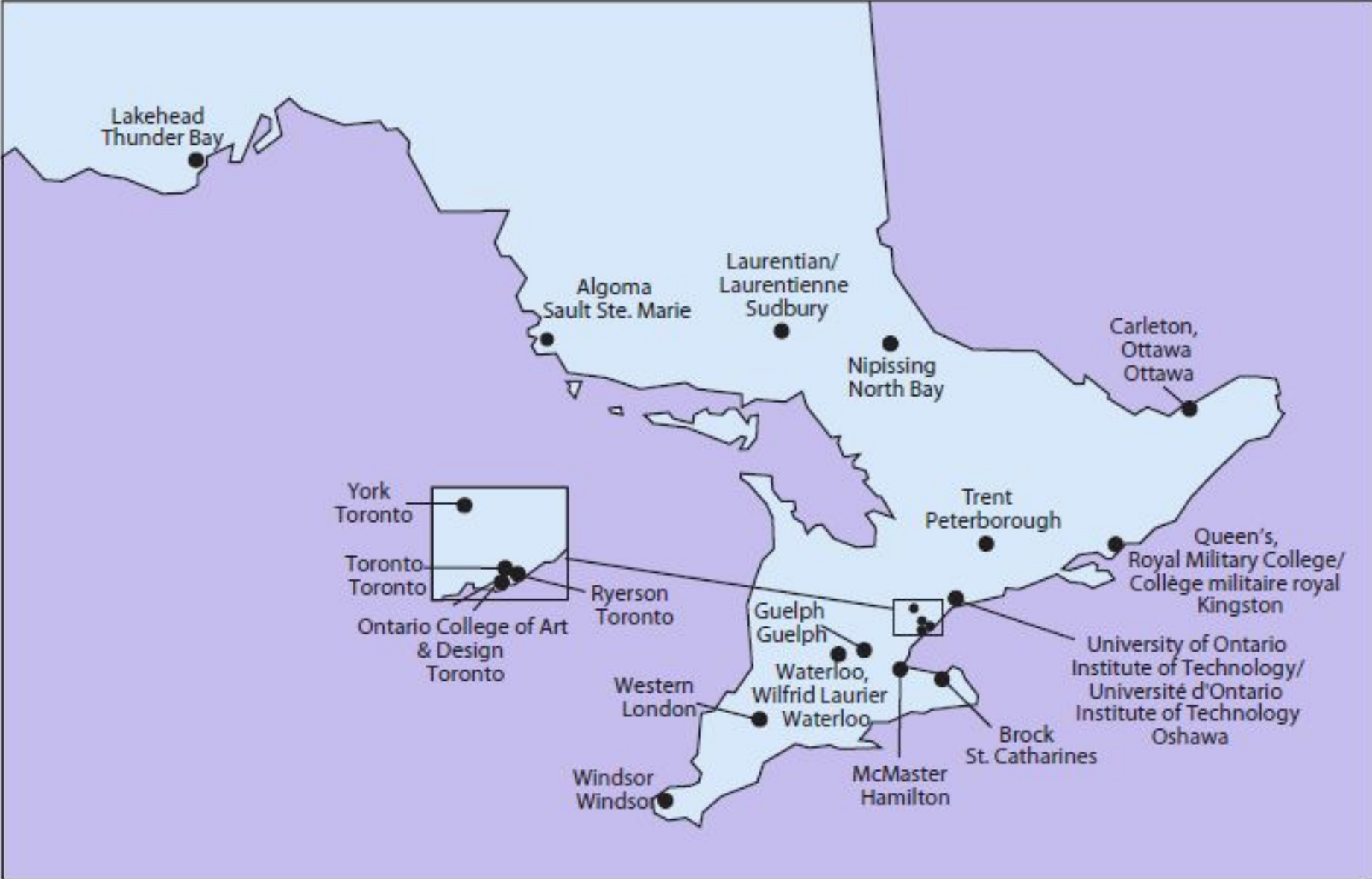

Step by Step

Requirements for University Application

- * 30 credits
- * 20+ hours of volunteer service (N/A)
- * ENG4U
- * 5 other grade 12 U or M credits
- * For some specialty programs, specific Science or Math credits may be required.
- * Specific schools will have other [application](#) requirements

Step 1: research university programs

- * <http://www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca/>
(Ontario Universities' Info)
- * Individual university websites
- * Record program choices and OUAC codes
- * Make note of all admission requirements and program specific deadlines

Step 2: Gather info needed to apply

- * Get your application access code letter which includes:
 - School number
 - Student number
 - Temporary PIN

- * If you are missing yours please contact us at sandra.storie@ugdsb.on.ca

Step 3: Apply

- * Use the application access code letter to create an account on [OUAC](#)
- * You will make a new password – record and keep in a safe place
- * Complete the application - [Click here for step by step instructions](#)
 - You don't need to complete it in one sitting
- * Submit your application with payment before the deadline
- * You will be given an OUAC reference #
 - You will use this # whenever you contact OUAC or a university

Step 4: After Applying

- * Log in and verify application details – make changes if necessary
- * Ensure the spam filter on the email address you used will accept email from OUAC and from the universities you applied to.
- * Make sure to verify your grade information after you get your report card

Most schools will send you an email with an applicant portal where they will communicate with you about your application to their school

As an applicant to Ryerson, this is our primary way of communicating with you so be sure to check your account often.

- [Upload your required documents](#) via your Choose>Ryerson Applicant Portal (if applicable).
- Determine what documents have been received by Ryerson and which ones remain outstanding.
- Be sure to read all of the letters we post to My Communications.
- Track your application status in My Application Status.

⚠ To access your Choose>Ryerson Applicant Portal account you must first create a **Ryerson Online Identity**. Complete the [Activation Form](#)  and include your **nine-digit Ryerson Student Number**. Your Ryerson Student Number was included in an email sent to you by Ryerson a few days after you applied.

⚠ The Choose>Ryerson Applicant Portal undergoes daily maintenance from 11 p.m. to 1:30 a.m. Eastern Time.

Important University Application Dates

- * **Oct/Nov:** Students should have their temporary PIN to start their application online
- * **Jan 15, 2021:** Deadline to submit completed applications to OUAC
- * **May 27, 2021:** latest date a student can expect a response from an Ontario University
- * **June 1, 2021:** Accept offers of Admission.

Application Fees

- * \$150 to apply
- * You can choose up to 3 program choices
- * \$50 for each additional choice
 - Fee is non-refundable
 - Application will not be processed without the fee

Applications to Out-of-Province Schools

- * It is a case by case scenario; each university is different with different deadlines
- * Most school applications are done online and each have separate application fees.
- * Generally students will be applying directly to the school and not on a collection site like OUAC



Applications to American Schools

- * Some schools have students apply through the [common application](#) but others you apply directly to the school. All deadlines different
- * SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) scores are usually required to apply to U.S. universities
- * In cases of athletics, students often have a liaison to help with the application process (ie.coach, scout)
- * With athletics you will also need to register with the [NCAA centre](#)
