Topic 7: Upcoming Council Events

- Winter Clothing Drive
 - An announcement went out, and we are planning to send a flyer home after
 Halloween to let families know about the donation bin and the sale happening in conjunction with the parent-teacher meetings in November.
 - Stacy A. offered to help with sorting donations. We need to find a place to store the donations as they come in. Could possibly store in part of Room 17.
 - **get an email out to teachers to make sure they include info in the any November newsletters**
- Winter Craft Sale: Tuesday December 19th
 - Led by Logan K and Heather M
 - The sooner we let people know the better so they can start crafting and making donations.
 - Logan will connect with Heather to discuss details.
 - Council will allocate funds for the subsidy so that kids who need assistance have funds to shop.
- Discussion around possible Vendor Sale (led by Brittney C/Heather M)
 - Do we combine it with Family Fun Night in June? In lieu of silent auction?
 - Or try to do it Nov/Dec in conjunction with other Vendor Sales in the neighbourhood?
 - Conclusion: We're going to aim for June this year, and revisit plans in January.

Topic 8: Pizza Day Update

- We've had 1 week of pizza. There have been a couple hiccups as the price increased slightly from the initial quote (Large pizza is cut into 8 slices instead of 10, but the slice sizes are more consistent) We are also paying for delivery now. We will reconsider other options but likely finish out this cycle and revisit in the New Year.
- Pay as you go and cash payments are requiring too much administration. There were also issues with families missing the deadline, and teacher's weren't aware that Pizza Orders were open, and so there wasn't as much communication with families.
- Can we set more reminders through School Cash Online? Michelle will ask Gayle about this.
- Is there a way for families to sponsor a slice for another student for a session? And for families to "request a free slice" through School Cash Online? Other schools do this and it seems to work. We will try it for the next cycle, and council will make up the difference if necessary.
- We will change the wording for the next session only offer School Cash online with an asterisk for those who can't use that option to email Council (instead of going to Gayle).

Topic 9: Movie Streaming Update

- Word came back from the Board that their IT department does not support the streaming application from the company where we purchased the license agreement. Other schools have had this problem as well. The Board is working on getting a refund for schools who are unable to use this streaming service. We are hoping to see a refund back from ACF for what we are not able to use for the rest of the year.
- The Board forwarded Streaming options that we do have available. Greg went through the catalogue to see if there was anything suitable for kids, but there wasn't much.
- We can purchase a license for a single ACF Title if we have a special event.
- Board is trying to negotiate for a Board-wide license with ACF for all the schools to access the streaming service. No update on timeline at this time.

Topic 10: Other

- Chef a l'École is it for all FI 1-6 PLUS primary english? Or Just for french? Just so we know who to gear "Scientists in School" to. Nathan has inquired about this.
- There is \$500 in funding available to council from the Board. We can choose what to do with the funds (e.g. pay babysitters for meetings, printing, etc?)
- We need to be able to print the limits on printing prove challenging for communicating upcoming events and fundraisers to families.
- Curriculum Nights: Kirk waiting to hear from Program Departments.
- Logan was asked to bring forward the issue of no dogs on school property.
 - Tricky during dismissal because there isn't a line of sight for kids getting dismissed for parents waiting on the sidewalk. Also some people are not following the new rules.
 - If there is no official board policy, the recommendation came from a Risk-Management newsletter, but given that for many years this wasn't a rule at Paisley, can it be reconsidered? (i.e. keep dogs on leash, on grassy area, etc)
 - It was discussed that dog owners can leave dogs at home if needed.
 - We are opting into the Council Insurance from the Board (roughly \$150 for the year).
