- 4) Presentation by Focus On Nature by Simon Bell & Robin May
  - Started by Bob Bell in 2008, was in 3 schools, has grown to 80 schools this year
  - Goal is to get children/ students be more physically active, and interact/ foster an appreciation for nature
  - All day programs for schools, need 3 volunteer staff as well as teacher and parent support so that children can have 1 on 1 help and do some group work
  - Not for profit organization, relies on grants, corporate sponsorship (Linamar etc)
  - \$300 cost to school for the day, actual cost closer to \$800
  - Have class set of cameras (30) and laptops
  - Use the Google Piccasa program to edit pictures
  - Children are excited to take their own photos and edit, each child has a chance to do a short slide show to class and pick their favorite photo- creates pride in their work, hopes to inspire them to continue seeing the beauty in nature
  - Learn basic photography composition, rule of thirds etc., teach them to think outside the box for composition (underside of flower, close up pictures etc)
  - More volunteers needed, issue finding volunteers who are willing to travel outside city of Guelph area, training 2x year (next training workshop Is next spring)
  - Pictures are displayed at GGH, Linamar staff lounge, Quebec Street Mall, Exhibit to be held at Ackers Building, Guelph Civic Museum
  - Kids LOVE the program-very positive feedback

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They currently have a survey for schools now open to gauge school supports- sent to school principals

- Learning Choices Group needs a parent rep. Rosemond has agreed to be our PIC rep. Group is responsible for hearing proposals from teachers, schools, parents, community groups for alternative learning programs that can be implemented by the board. Must present plan that is sustainable, fair, inclusive etc. (ie. CELP, IB, DaVinci) \*\*see board website for more information on current programs available
- Online payment available for schools for lunch programs, class trips etc. Parents noted that some schools are pushing too hard, saying it is the only option- Brent to investigate and communicate to schools.

- Current government court found the previous government removal of union's bargaining rights as unconstitutional, not resolved yet
- EQAO- problems with testing at the high school level- timeline of breakdown was discussed. Parent, teachers and students are all very upset, unclear yet if any tests will be counted, likely not. There are huge costs to the tests- computers, scribes and aides, modifications for students. EQAO at this time will not compensate for costs to repeat the test
