Principal Report (Kelley Jones)	 (1) Foundational Student Achievement Science of Reading Report cards available Feb 16th- IT is working on getting things to run more smoothly with the retrieval of the online report cards. (2) Inspiring Life-Long Love of Learning Cozy up & read day – whole school event January 26th Family Literacy Day- Jan 27th – encouraging families to celebrate by reading together (3) Champion Health & Well Being Ongoing clubs at Ponsonby, including a drama club that is set to perform a play the first week of May. Grades 5/6 learning Ukelele Sports activities at the school- volleyball, track and field (June 13th at Elora Public), soccer. (4) Ensure Equity of Access & Outcomes Kindergarten registration until Jan 27th 2023 Excellent feedback about the Winter Concert, its inclusive variety, and celebration of peoples' differences. (5) Lead through Sustainability Spring cleanup of mulch piles will likely be a student initiative, with students already voluntarily moving mulch. (6) School Projects SCHOOL FIELD TRIP: Whole school fieldtrip to Camp Brébeuf in Rockwood on Thursday, June 29, 2023 (last day of school). Cost per student is approximately \$35 including busses. SCHOOL PLAY: planned for Tues and Wednesday evening of Education week (first week of May). Council has offered to give \$200 towards this, as part of instructional supplies and learning materials, which will go towards the script and costumes, etc.

Treasurer's Report (1	 Budget Review Budget shows a lot of money allocated to the library & instructional supplies (largely from Winter Market). This limits the money for other categories. Bottle drive can be added to budget (under tech/literacy), earning \$317.60, and Fundscript earned approx. \$530. Awaiting receipts from council members and Rachel Ricker. We are still due to receive \$500 from the Board. Consider allocating market funds raised to another category next year. 'Anything' column is unallocated funds. Some may be used to increase teacher budgets, for which \$800 was earmarked last year.
	 Classroom Budgets Need to give teachers a firm deadline for spending. Darcy: we have enough funds that council can grant specific requests or wishlist items, favoring those that would benefit the whole school rather than one classroom. E.g. coding robots, lego, volleyball poles. Other wishlist items include: learning carpet, light table. School budget has been used to buy some wishlist items this year. Darcy suggested that due to the large amount of funds for instructional supplies, council may choose to purchase some extra instructional supplies that may have traditionally been bought by school funds, with the idea that some school funds can in turn pay for part of the class trip (which would normally come from council). It would be the same amounts of money spent. Motion (proposed by Darcy): <i>every full-time educator gets \$100</i>, and <i>part time educators</i> (Amy, Beth, Jey) get <i>\$50</i>. Other staff members would not qualify. Rebeccah (1st), Lindsay (2nd). Motion approved. Other Spending Options Gaggaball- Motion put forward to commit approximately

	 estimated cost, with the other half paid for by the school). Darcy (1st), Rebeccah (2nd), Motion approved. Schlockey – Lindsay will donate a schlockey board to the school as a trial run. Will need wooden hockey sticks. Scientists in the Classroom - over the next month or so, Christina can work with Kelley and some teachers to discuss and organize some fun and educational age-appropriate science activities.
