Dear Primrose Parents/Guardians:

As we shared last week, we are investigating turbidity in the water from our new well. A team has been contracted to identify the cause of this cloudiness. We hope to share details in the coming days.

During this investigation, we have connected the school back to a water tanker to be used as a source for water. The tanker was connected to the school on the afternoon of Wednesday, March 29. On the afternoon of Tuesday, April 4, the tanker ran out of water. We are unsure how we depleted our water supply so quickly. Fortunately, we had our porta-potties and handwashing stations on site for use.

Moving forward while we investigate, we will be regularly checking a flow monitor device on the tanker to watch for any unexplained usage. We will also be scheduling refills on the tanker every two days regardless of water levels. This plan will remain in place until the cause of the turbidity is determined and remedied.
