Dear Primrose Parents/Guardians:

We wanted to provide a final update with regards to the newly constructed well. The well has been reconnected to the school and has been working well. We have had no water issues since its connection on May 8, 2023.

In line with the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks recommendation, the additional water samples passed and can be used for food preparation or consumption. While we were awaiting water samples, we had turned off water supply to food prep sinks and water fountains.

Drinking water dispensers continue to be available throughout the school. We are still scheduled to install point-of-use reverse osmosis systems at water fountains and two kitchen sinks. This additional work will happen over the summer.

The water tanker and portable toilets are scheduled to be picked up by the end of this week.

I personally would like to thank the team from Facilities Services, Ms. Millsap, Ms. Hopkins, Primrose staff and the entire Primrose community for your patience and support as we worked to ensure a consistent, safe and sustainable water source for the school.
