#### Principal's Report – April 4, 2024

OPP presentations today and tomorrow: grades 3-8. K-2 later in the springtime.

**Chef L'Ecole, grades 4-8 a great success!** Thank you to all of our parents/caregivers who volunteered their time.

**EQAO preparation:** May 27th to June 6th. Attempting to break up testing over longer periods of time, in small groups. We are hoping this helps children be more successful. Children are using technology and using board approved resources to prepare for the testing. Our school was chosen to do some pre testing from our program department to help us determine our next steps. Families will be getting letters closer to testing to explain more.

**Staffing for 24/25:** We have maintained 13 classes, number of staff allotted to us, and the LRC 8 classroom. All allocations are tentative. Enrollment is submitted again in June and September. I do not take teacher requests for placement. Staff build classes based on student needs, friendships, groups for small group instruction etc.
