

ITEM PICKUP INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTS (MAY 27 2020)

We will have two pick up dates for retrieval of students personal items. On June 4 we are inviting single child families and on June 5 we are inviting multiple child families.

Please make sure to come on the correct date, check the time according to your last name and follow the guidelines for safe entry.

Pickup Times - Please arrive **at the time** listed under your child's last name initial.

NOTE: You will likely wait in line for a period of time before entering the school as we will be practicing proper social distancing practices.

WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE HAND

- Please DO NOT bring bags into the school (bags will be provided)
- You must complete the online self-assessment tool:
<https://covid-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/>
- There will be no outdoor supervision and the playground will be closed
- There will be no access to classrooms or washrooms during the pickup process
- Only one adult may come to pick up belongings (all children must stay home)

BEFORE ENTERING THE SCHOOL MAKE SURE

- You have NO symptoms (fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat or shortness of breath)
- Have NOT travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days
- Have NOT been in close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19

UPON ENTERING THE SCHOOL

- Please use the hand sanitizer provided

- You are strongly encouraged to wear a mask as per Public Health recommendations, but one will not be provided for you

Please remember to practise social distance and keep a 2-metre (6 feet) space between you and others at all times. Please follow the instructions of staff present.

THE PROCESS

- Arrive at the school at your assigned time (you will likely need to wait in line for a period of time). If you drive, please make sure that you are following all Town of Fergus posted parking rules. Spaces in the school parking lot are first come, first served.
- Line up at the front doors, standing 6 feet from the person in front of you (there will be markers on the ground/pylons indicating the appropriate distance).
- Lost and found items will be placed on tables please look and only touch what you need to take.
- Enter when invited
- If your child has medication that is stored in the office, indicate this to the person at the front door and they will make sure you receive this medication.
- If your child's belongings will be in a labelled bag outside their classroom near their hook. Please check the coat rack for your child's items as well.
- Use the hand sanitizer upon entering and exiting
- Proceed directly to your child's classroom, following the arrows on the floor (this may mean you will need to take a longer route - please do so). If you don't know the location of your child's classroom, a staff member will be able to direct you.
- Continue to follow the arrows for any other classes you need to get to
- Once you have picked up all belongings, please exit the door that is directed by the arrows and return to your vehicle

FAQ

I have children at the school with different last names - when do I come?

Come during the time allotted for the last name of your *child who's closest to the beginning of the alphabet* and pick up belongings for *all* of your children.

A parent/guardian cannot come on the date/time scheduled. Can we send another family member? YES - please let the classroom teacher know ahead of time who will be picking up for your child. If this is not possible, please provide the individual picking up with a note indicating your child's name and your name and that you give them permission to pick up.

A parent/guardian cannot come on the date/time scheduled. Can another parent with a child at your school pick our child(rens) belongings up for us? YES - please let the classroom teacher know ahead of time who will be picking up for your child. If this is not possible, please provide the individual picking up with a note indicating your child's name and your name and that you give them permission to pick up.

Can our child pick up their own belongings?

No. ONE adult must come.

My child has library books/home reading levelled books/classroom, home bags, resources and manipulatives. Can I bring them?

Yes. There will be a box at the front doors for you to return school items. It will be clearly labelled. If you have a chromebook at home this does NOT need to be returned at this time.

What will happen with unclaimed items?

Any unclaimed items will be bagged and stored until schools re-open.

What if time or date doesn't work for my schedule?
