Teachers want to thank parents for all they’re doing to support at home like printing, explanations, tech help etc. - other things mentioned are grade 8’s are talking about Grade 8 Grad, kindies are doing a mystery show and share and a virtual field trip to the ROM - participation is very high, kids are doing their very best - teachers are missing their students
