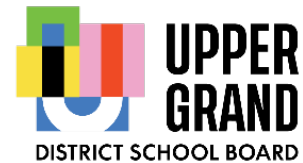


# Health Support Services Policy 509

## 1. Policy Statement

It is the policy of the Upper Grand District School Board to provide Health Support Services for students in accordance with Ministry of Education guidelines.

## 2. Details

- 2.1 It is the responsibility of the appropriate superintendent to administer this policy.
- 2.2 It is the responsibility of the principal to implement this policy.
- 2.3 The principal may consult with the Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph Public Health (WDG Public Health), the Waterloo-Wellington Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) and Central West LHIN when establishing in-school procedures.
- 2.4 This policy will be reviewed as required.
- 2.5 This policy shall be implemented in accordance with the Health Support Services Procedures Manual 509-A and the Health Support Services Resource Handbook 509-B.
