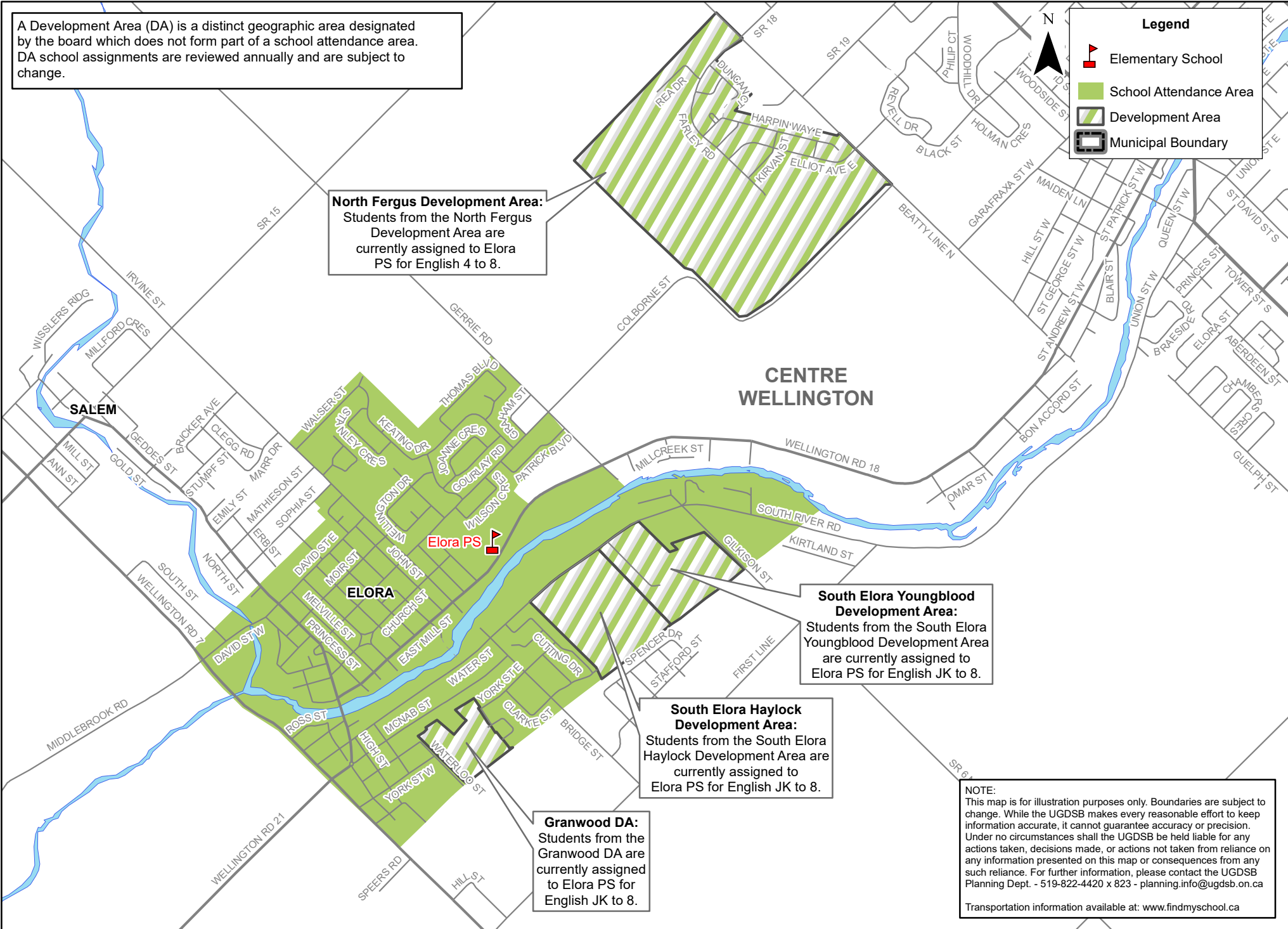


# Elora PS English JK to 5 Attendance Area (Map 1 of 3)

**North Fergus Development Area:**  
Students from the North Fergus Development Area are currently assigned to Elora PS for English 4 to 8.

**South Elora Youngblood Development Area:**  
Students from the South Elora Youngblood Development Area are currently assigned to Elora PS for English JK to 8.

**South Elora Haylock Development Area:**  
Students from the South Elora Haylock Development Area are currently assigned to Elora PS for English JK to 8.

**Granwood DA:**  
Students from the Granwood DA are currently assigned to Elora PS for English JK to 8.

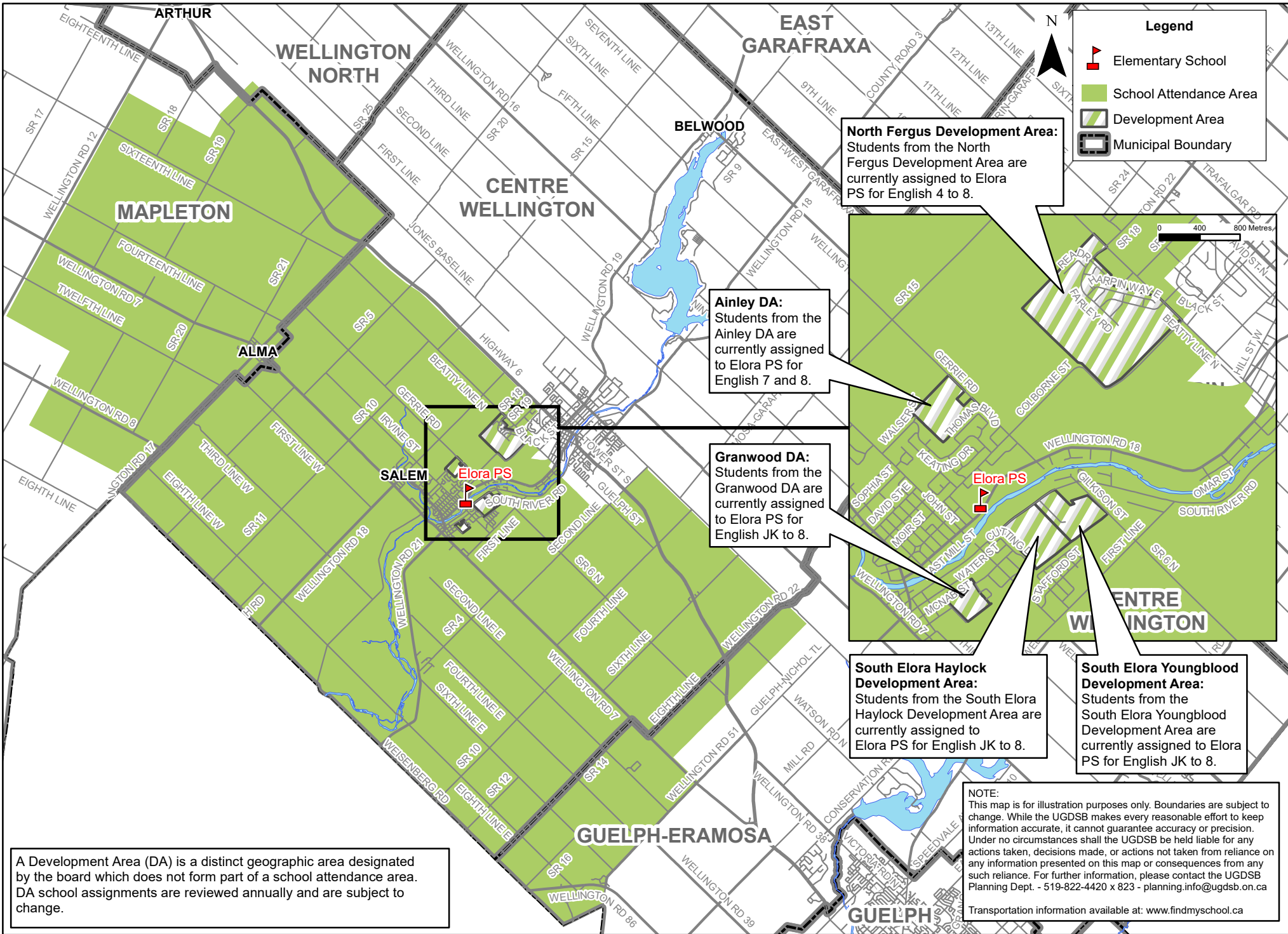
**Grade 6 Provisional Accommodation:**  
Effective September 2014, all Ponsonby PS Grade 6 students will attend Ponsonby PS subject to annual monitoring. Staff have been directed to implement the transition of Grade 6 students from Ponsonby PS to Elora PS in 2015/16 or any year thereafter, if enrolment projections indicate that there will be more than 203 pupils at Ponsonby PS. Further, staff be directed to inform the parents of Ponsonby PS Grade 6 students of the transition to Elora PS by the end of February for the change to be in effect for the coming school year.
