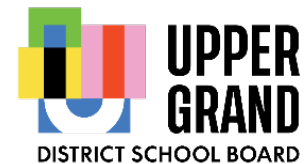


Use of Corporate Resources for Elections Policy 111

1. Policy Statement

It is the policy of the Upper Grand District School Board to ensure trustees and staff adhere to accountable and transparent practices, relating to the use of corporate resources during school board, municipal, provincial and federal elections. This policy applies to all trustees, registered trustee candidates seeking election (including acclaimed candidates) and staff. This policy supplements the provisions of the Trustee Code of Conduct (Policy 103).

2. Details

- 2.1 It is the responsibility of the Superintendent of Finance to administer this policy.
- 2.2 It is the responsibility of the Board to ensure that in compliance with the [Municipal Elections Act, 1996](#), the [Election Finances Act, 1990](#), and the [Canada Elections Act, 2000](#), public funds are not used for any election-related purposes, including the promotion of or opposition to the candidacy of a person for elected office.
